



## The Environmental Farm Plan Program Announces the Addition of Planning Advisors to BC

The Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) Program, ARDCorp and the BC Ministry of Agriculture are pleased to announce the successful addition of seven (7) trained and recognized Planning Advisors (PA's) December 2010.

The EFP Program contracts PA's to assist BC producers through an assessment of their farming operations' activities from the perspective of potential environmental risks. A planning work book has been developed specifically for this program, designed to guide producers to review various components of their operation. Based on the answers, the work book clearly identifies which areas could benefit from improvements to reduce any environmental risk, or potential thereof. It also provides opportunity to educate producers on current government legislation around environmental issues.

Planning Advisors are located throughout British Columbia. A need was identified to complement the existing, hard working Planning Advisors to better assist producers through the program. A training program was held in this past fall. All 7 completed the course requirements and are now recognized PA's with the EFP Program.
